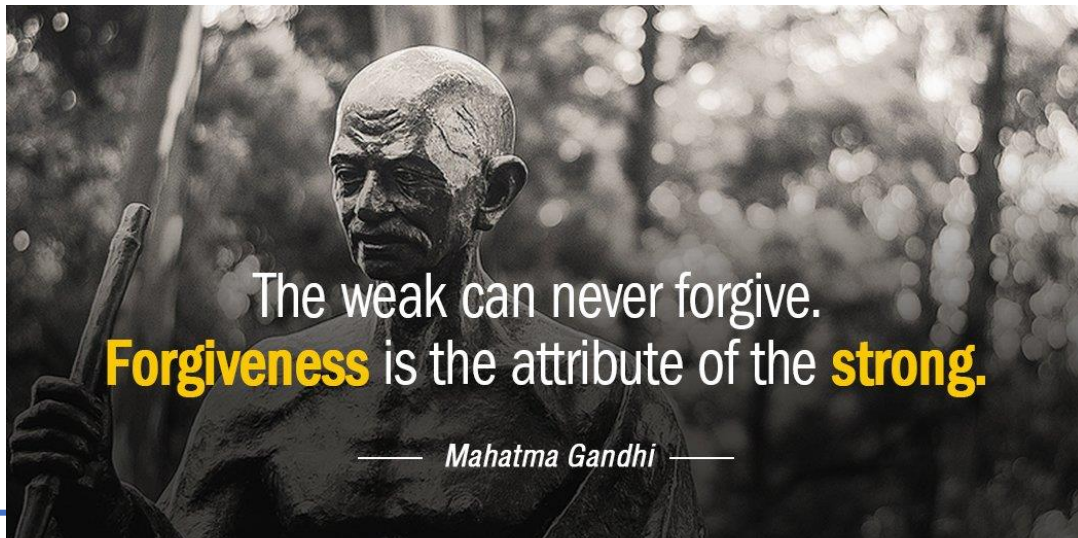


Spring Term 2023 First Half
