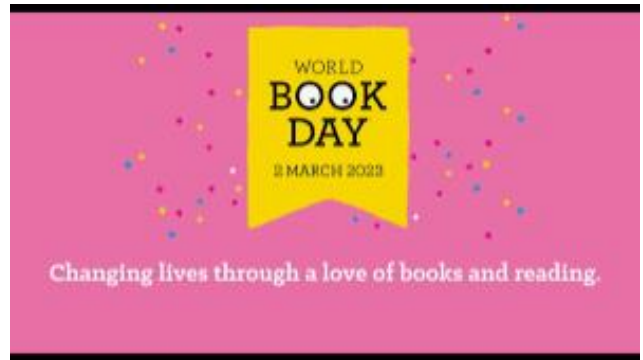


On behalf of the staff and governors, I wish you all a very happy holiday and thank you for all your support this year so far. Best wishes for the half term holiday!
