Morning Routine:

In a morning you will hang your coat and bag on your peg, take out your reading folder and make your way into the classroom.



There will always be a morning task on the interactive whiteboard for you to look at and discuss/write about while you sit on the carpet.



Next, we take the register and check the lunch menu for the day. We chat about the morning task and today's learning, before going to assembly or starting our phonics lesson.

We take turns with phonics, half of the children have phonics first, while the other half go onto the big yard for bikes, trikes, running track or park time (gross motor).



After phonics, we go off and learn in provision.



There are lots of exciting things to do in the classroom and outside in the Reception playground. We can go outside most of the time, every day.

After provision time, we all come back to the carpet and learn English together. Some of us go back into provision to learn and some of us sit in groups with the grownups to finish off English. We all take it in turns.

After English and provision time, we get ready for lunch. First, we tidy up and 'reset' for the afternoon, then we sit on the carpet and discuss our learning from the morning. We talk about our learning in the afternoon and any other interesting topics we have. Finally, we sing some songs, wash our hands, and go for lunch.



Afternoon Routine:

In the afternoon, we come back into class from the big yard. We sit on the carpet take the register and choose what we are going to eat for dinner the next day. After that we talk about the learning we are going to do in the afternoon. Miss Steward then teaches Maths. After Maths, we go and learn in the indoor and outdoor provision.



Midway through the afternoon, we come back to the carpet and learn about other interesting things like R.E, Art and Understanding the World. We also go up to the library on Thursdays.

Then we collect our belongings, line up and meet are parents at the brown gate where the Reception playground meets the big yard.


