### Computing - Improving Mouse Skills

- To log into a computer and access a website
- I can recognise what we mean by a computer

- I can use different tools to create a desired effect

## Geography

- To use geographical sources (maps) to identify key features of a locality (the Year 1 classroom).
- To make simple observations of a locality using simple geographical vocabulary.
- To speak about simple geographical concepts such as what they can see where.
- To use maps and other images to talk about everyday life e.g. school.
- To describe some places and features using basic geographical vocabulary.
- To use simple fieldwork and observational skills when studying the geography of their school and its grounds.
- To name and locate some places in their locality.
- To begin to identify physical and human features.
- To begin to observe and name different weather types.
- To present information using geographical knowledge (present own weather forecasts and create weather map using symbols and a key)
